

Lord, Teach Us to Pray" – A Reflection on the Lord's Prayer from Luke's Gospel

When the disciples asked Jesus to teach them to pray, they weren't simply looking for words – they wanted to learn how to pray like him. Luke's version of the Lord's Prayer begins simply with "Father." Unlike Matthew's longer version, Luke gives us a deeply intimate, personal glimpse into how Jesus addresses God. This one word – Father – reminds us that Christian prayer begins in relationship. Luke, more than any other Gospel, shows us Jesus at prayer, and that matters.

The Lord's Prayer isn't just a formula – it's a way of life. It teaches us to approach God with intimacy, to trust in His provision, to extend forgiveness, and to persist in hope.

Let us continue to pray consistently, trust deeply, and remember that God hears – and responds.
