They spent the day meeting other young people from across Scotland, taking part in games and activities, and hearing talks and input around the themes of the Nicene Creed and the Reformation, as well as joining for a prayer service for Christian Unity at St John's Kirk. The day ended with Mass in St John's Church at which we were delighted to have some of our young people serving.

YOUTH EVENINGS: Our popular Youth Evenings return on Sunday 28th September for young people in P6-S4 and we can't wait to welcome young people in South and North Ayrshire this month and next!

Queen Margaret Academy Cluster (St Margaret's Cathedral, Ayr): Launches on Sunday 28th September. For the first evening, we'll be thinking about some of the stories we read in the Bible and what we can learn from them today.

St Matthew's Academy Cluster (St Peter-in-Chains, Ardrossan): Launches on Sunday 26th October. For the first evening, we'll be thinking about Mary and how she is a model, guide and inspiration for us in our own lives.

St Joseph's Academy Cluster (St Joseph's, Kilmarnock) & St Joseph's College Cluster (St Teresa's, Dumfries): Resume on Sunday 28th September.
