JUBILEE YEAR OF HOPE: During this Jubilee Year of Hope, each of the four deaneries of our diocese has prepared a presentation of the four Apostolic Constitutions of the Second Vatican Council.

St Margaret's Deanery (South Ayrshire) has produced online material for Sacrosanctum Concilium, the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy which is now available for viewing on YouTube on the "RC Diocese of Galloway" @rcdgalloway channel. This Constitution set the direction for modern liturgical renewal in the Catholic Church. Its goal was to deepen the faithful's participation in the liturgy, enrich the use of Scripture, and ensure that worship was both faithful to tradition and accessible to today's communities.
