As we prepare for Christmas it can be easy to lose sight of Christ among the busyness and preparations, this is an important opportunity to seek to restore our relationship with Christ by seeking forgiveness for our sins.

On Friday 12th December at 7.00 pm in St Joseph's, Kilmarnock, Young Adults who took part in the Camino de Santiago will be speaking about their experiences. They'll be sharing photos, stories, and taking questions about why it was so significant for all of those who took part.
