MASS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT:

During this Year of Prayer to the Holy Spirit, Bishop Frank Dougan is celebrating Votive Masses of the Holy Spirit in different parishes and schools of the diocese.

On Thursday 23rd April, the Bishop will celebrate a Mass of the Holy Spirit in St Joseph's at 6 pm. Everyone from the Kilmarnock parishes (and beyond) is encouraged to make an effort to participate in this most important diocesan gathering as we ask the Holy Spirit to prepare each of us for the mission of our parish communities in the years ahead.



Prayer to the Holy Spirit

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in us the fire of your love.

Send forth your Spirit and we shall be created and you shall renew the face of the earth.

O God, who has taught the hearts of your faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit; grant that by the gift of the same Spirit we may be always truly wise and ever rejoice in your consolation. Through Christ our Lord. Amen. St Ninian, pray for us.

MINIBUS TRIP: These trips are open to anyone in the three parishes – sign up in the porch in St Joseph's. Following the success of the St Joseph's minibus trips in recent years, the first minibus trip of 2026 will take place on Monday 4th May to New Abbey.

We will leave St Joseph's at 10.30 am and celebrate Mass in St Mary's Chapel, New Abbey on arrival. After Mass we will have an afternoon tea lunch in the Abbey Cottage Tea Room and then an opportunity to explore New Abbey. We will return to St Joseph's for approximately 5.00 pm.

The cost per person is £27, payable on the day and includes transport and lunch. If you would like to take part, please sign-up in the porch in St Joseph's. If this trip is over-subscribed, those on the waiting list will be given first priority for the next trip in May.
